Not all conditions may exist at your business, but this checklist is intended to provide of an overview of the types of hazards that are common in parking lots.

ENTRANCES/EXITS

Entrance/Exit features are ADA compliant.

Entrances/exits are kept free of obstacles.

HOUSEKEEPING

Food housekeeping is maintained throughout the lot and adjacent features (e.g., benches, pavilions, plant basins, trach cans, etc.).

LIGHTING

Parking lot and perimeter lights are in good condition and turn on at dusk

LOT MARKINGS/SIGNAGE

Parking blocks are anchored to the pavement, maintained properly, and clearly marked with high visibility paint, preferably safety yellow.

All parking lot striping, pedestrian crosswalks, traffic directions, and curb warnings are easily visible and well maintained.

Curb cuts and wheelchair ramps are well differentiated.

Stanchions, lighting posts, and other uprights are clearly marked with high visibility paint.

Traffic signage is well placed, in good repair, stable and presents no hazards.

Special areas (e.g., pickup/delivery, access routes) are controlled with lines or directional arrows that are well marked and prominent

Signs, utility poles, cash meters, power transformers, fire hydrants, etc., are well marked and protected.



PAVEMENT CONDITION

There are no potholes or cracked paving in the parking lot or sidewalks.

RAILINGS

Guard rails, fences, and handrails are stable, well maintained, and structurally sound.

SECURITY

Perimeter security, such as fencing, is maintained in good condition.

Cameras are installed and active that provide a good view of the area

STAIRS/STEPS

Stair treads are kept clean, in good repair, and have nonslip surface.

Stairs have handrails where warranted.

Steps at building entrances and exits are free of slip and fall hazards (snow, ice, grease, water, etc.)

SNOW AND ICE

Snow shoveling frequency at entryway and sidewalks is completed before building occupants and guests arrive, and then periodically as conditions warrant.



Snowplowing frequency for the parking lot is appropriate for the conditions.
